

Medicare Rebates are eligible for diagnostic mammograms as per the details stipulated by the requesting practitioner on the request form.

A Mammogram, without the necessary clinical indications on the request form, is considered screening which does not entitle the patient to a Medicare Rebate. A private fee will apply for non-Medicare Mammography exams.

ALL AGES

→ The past occurrence of breast malignancy in the patient

→ Medicare Rebate Eligible

→ Symptoms or indications of breast disease found on examination of the patient:

Examples include:

- Focal pain or tenderness
- Lump in the breast
- Discharge
- Thickening

→ Medicare Rebate Eligible

→ Significant history of breast or ovarian malignancy in the patients family

→ Medicare Rebate Eligible
